

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COEBURN, VIRGINIA IMPOSING A TAX ON MEALS PURSUANT TO SECTION 58.1-3840 OF THE CODE OF VIRGINIA AND IMPOSING PENALTIES THEREFORE AND EXEMPTIONS

It is hereby ORDAINED that that the "Ordinance Imposing a Tax on Meals Pursuant to Section 58.1-3840 of the Code of Virginia and Imposing Penalties Therefore and Exemptions" adopted by the Coeburn Town Council on the 4th day of June, 1990 be amended as follows:

Section II. Tax levied; rate

For every meal or meals served in the town by a restaurant for consumption on or off its premises, and for every meal or meals delivered in the Town of Coeburn by a caterer, there is hereby levied and imposed upon the purchaser thereof an excise tax of seven ~~five~~ (7 ~~5~~) percent of the total amount paid for the meal or meals. All fractional amounts of one-half cent (\$0.005) or more shall be rounded up to the next cent.

All other sections of the original ordinance shall remain in effect as adopted.




